



Veterinarian Review

These standards have been proposed for FARM Animal Care Version 4.0. Currently, FARM is operating under Version 3.0 which remain in effect until they are replaced by action of the NMPF Board of Directors (“Board”). Proposed standards for Version 4.0 will be presented to the Board for its consideration and approval at its meeting in June 2019, and FARM will not operate under Version 4.0 until approval by the Board and January 1, 2020



The facility has a written Veterinarian Client Patient Relationship (VCPR) that is signed by the farm owner and Veterinarian of Record annually.

Rationale

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The written herd health plan is reviewed annually by the Veterinarian of Record

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All written protocols are translated into languages understood by individuals with animal care responsibilities.

Maintaining consistency of standard from previous versions. Ensures consistent training to the protocol that protocols can be understood by diverse workforce.
