

FARM Version 5 Development Memo *July - September*

WHERE ARE WE WITH VERSION 5 DEVELOPMENT?

The National Farmers Assuring Responsible Management Program (FARM) Animal Care Task Force (ACTF) has initiated the revision process that will inform the development of a new version (5) of the Animal Care component of the FARM program. To date, the ACTF has held meetings on July 12 and Sept. 13, to discuss and review the progress that has been thus far in Version 4. The July meeting acted as a kick-off event, with discussions focusing on management and administrative topics. Upcoming meetings and relevant events were highlighted for the group and a review of the governance scope was provided. The communication strategy between all governance committees of the FARM Program was coordinated to ensure a comprehensive understanding of how information will be shared

going forward. To close this meeting, next steps were discussed, and the focus groups and survey were highlighted as a next priority.

FOCUS GROUPS

In the last three weeks of August,
Acer Consulting Group facilitated
focus groups with approximately 10
members from each of the following
industry stakeholders: veterinarians,
farmers, researchers,
cooperatives/processors. The focus

groups asked participants to describe what they felt were highpriority animal care topics, what



aspects of Version 4 should be changed or updated, and what they would like to see included in Version 5 of FARM Animal Care. The feedback gathered from the focus groups was used to develop the industry-wide feedback survey.



SURVEY

The results of these focus groups were summarized at the September ACTF meeting and the November NMPF Animal Health and Well-Being Committee (AHWB) meeting. Common themes from the results were discussed and ACTF and AHWB members were given the opportunity to ask questions, give suggestions, and provide feedback. The meetings closed with a review of the development and distribution of a nation-wide survey for relevant stakeholders to provide feedback. The survey response period was from Sept. 22 – Nov. 1 and allowed farmers, veterinarians, cooperatives/processor staff and other industry stakeholders the opportunity to provide their feedback and suggestions for the FARM governance structure to consider as they look to the new version.

Preliminary results of the survey will be shared with the National Milk Producers Federation Board of Directors in mid-November, as part of the National Dairy Board/National Milk Producers Federation/United Dairy Industry Association's Annual Meeting's Town Hall and for the full industry in a virtual Industry Town Hall to be held on **December 14th at 1 ET**. Registration for this webinar is now open.
